Art classes will resume starting January 3, 2012!!

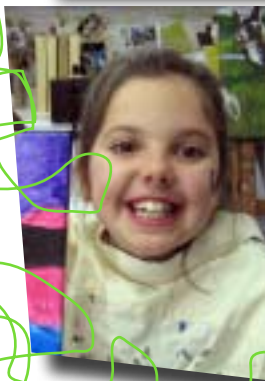
ART SHOW IN MARCH...
